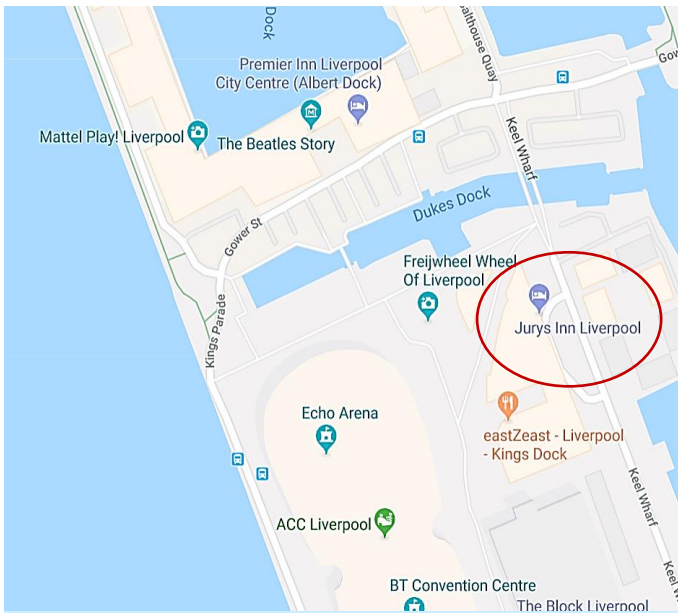
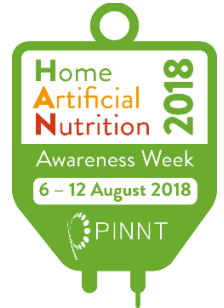




**When:** Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2018

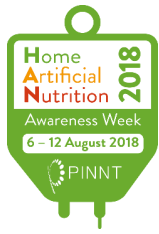

### **Programme for the day**

**1.15 – 3.15pm – A range of workshop and breakout sessions will be held.**

1. Dietitian led session – Enteral tube types, sites and troubleshooting.
2. Pharmacist led session – Find out more about multi-chamber parenteral nutrition (PN) bags.
3. Benefits – help and advice from a professional benefits advisor.
4. PN ambulatory pumps – hear from the companies about their products; possibly see new pumps that may be available in England soon!
5. Travel – no matter how near or far, advice from fellow patients about travelling with home artificial nutrition.

**Exhibition:** Enteral and parenteral homecare companies, pump manufacturers, Enteral tube clear device, modified clothing for tube fed children, enteral pump insert for use with normal rucksacks, pouches to protect central lines when swimming, plus a full range of PINNT information.

### **Useful information**

**Meeting venue:** Jury's Inn is situated in a prime location in Liverpool. Close to attractions and easily accessible via public transport and car. Albert Dock is right next door to the venue.

**Parking:** Kings Waterfront next door to Jury's Inn Hotel. 1 hour: 80p, 2 hours: £1.60, 3 hours: £2.40, 4 hours, £3.20, 5-12 hours: £4.00 and 24 hours: £8.00. Correct at time of printing. Alternative parking is available nearby, please investigate prior to attending.

**Trains:** Nearest stations and distance from hotel if walking, James Street Station - for the Wirral Line – (6 mins walk), Moorfields Station- for the Northern Line – (12 mins walk), Liverpool Central station – (9 mins walk), Lime Street Station – (12 mins walk).

**By car:** **Manchester:** 55 minutes by car via the M62 or 45 minutes by train, **Birmingham:** one hour 55 minutes by car via the M6 or one hour 45 minutes by train, **Leeds:** one hour 25 minutes by car via the M62 or one hour 45 minutes by train or **London** four hours by car via the M6 and M40, or two hours 20 minutes by train.

**Transfer from train stations:** From £5.00 depending on the station.

**Refreshments:** Tea, coffee, cordial and fruit juices will be available. Dietary requirements will be taken into account if notified in advance. There will be small bites, nibbles as well as a sandwich lunch.

**Accommodation at the venue and the locality:** Liverpool has a wide range of accommodation to select from if you are thinking of extending your stay and seeing the sights. PINNT is not able to arrange accommodation on your behalf. We suggest you look around and book the style of accommodation that suits your needs.

**Facilities at the venue:** PINNT will supply all your refreshments during the running time of our event. If you have any specific needs, please ensure there are details on the RSVP slip. The hotel does offer a range of bars and eating places should you wish to investigate these yourself.

**RSVP slip:** Please return the RSVP slip to let us know if you're coming, or not as the case may be. We need to know the numbers of those eating as well as the total number of people attending. Special dietary requirements can be listed on the RSVP slip.
